PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW

1. I, the parent, approve my child's application for membership to Boys & Girls Clubs of Marin and Petaluma (BGCMP) and will notify the BGCMP staff of any and all changes to membership application.
2. I understand that BGCMP maintains a NO REFUND POLICY.
3. I understand that my child cannot be left at BGCMP earlier or later than the Club's established hours of operation.
4. I understand that in the event of extreme or recurring discipline problems, my child may not have use of the Club and/or participation in its programs for a prescribed period of time.
5. I, the parent, am registering my child in program(s) and am responsible for payment.
6. I, the legal parent/guardian of the current member, do hereby irrevocably consent to and authorize the use and reproduction by BGCMP of photographs taken of the member I am registering for the purpose of posting on the Club's website and/or for publishing in the newspaper or other brochure unless directly stated in writing to the Program Director.
7. I understand that the member I am registering will have access to computer use in the computer center, with club supervision.

BGCMP maintains an open door policy. If it's a parent's desire that his/her child remain at the Club until picked up by a designated person, the responsibility for this lies solely with the parent and the child. The Club staff will NOT be held liable should any child leave the premises without permission. Please contact the Program Director with questions or concerns.

I hereby give my child permission to participate in BGCMP. I understand that the BGCMP is not responsible for personal injury or loss of property. I give BGCMP staff permission to take my child to the nearest qualified physician for observation or treatment in case of an emergency. In the event medical attention other than basic first aid needs to be administered, a concerted effort will be made to contact the parent/guardian or family doctor before any further action is taken on the part of BGCMP.

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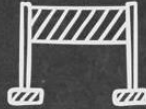
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Adult Code of Conduct

Boys & Girls Clubs of Marin and Petaluma is a non-profit organization with its sole purpose being the promotion of youth activities. These goals could not be achieved without the participation and cooperation of parents, guardians, and other adult participants. You play an important part in the Clubs' athletic programs, even if you do not coach or volunteer your time. Good sportsmanship is a concept that we strive to teach our members. Adult misbehavior at youth sporting events is something that has gained national attention, and has served to undermine youth sports in this country: it is our goal to make our sporting events a positive experience.

Sportsmanship is defined as fairness in following the rules of the game or conduct and attitude considered as befitting participants in sports, especially fair play, courtesy, striving spirit, and grace in winning and in losing. It's about respect for self, the opposition, game officials and the game itself.

"Children grow up to become what they learn."

This agreement is intended to establish and sustain a positive environment for the youth who participate in our athletic programs.

1. I will encourage, but not force my child or any child to participate in athletic programs.
2. I will assist the Club in teaching my child and others in the Club that rules are important and will instill in the child that rules are important.
3. I understand that children learn best by example and that I will always attempt to set a good example for my child and any other children who participate or have any involvement with the Club.
4. I will teach my child that victory is important and that honesty and hard work are equally rewarding and important.
5. I will teach my child that one individual cannot win a team championship.
6. I will teach and demonstrate by example the importance of good sportsmanship in victory and in defeat.
7. I will not publicly question the honesty, integrity or judgment of the volunteer coaches or other adult umpires or referees.
8. I understand that verbal and physical abuse is not to be tolerated against anyone in this Club; verbal abuse includes profanity and disrespectful language.
9. I understand that racial epithets or negative innuendo related to a person's race, religion or ethnicity will not be tolerated.
10. I recognize that respect among adults is necessary for success in this Club and that all adult volunteers and staff are entitled to respect, as are the children.

As a parent, guardian or spectator, I will handle disagreements in a responsible and appropriate manner. I agree not to engage in divisive activity such as verbal and physical confrontation. I agree to first submit my complaints to the Director of Athletics for BGCMP.

By signing below, I understand that if I violate this agreement, I will be subject to disciplinary action, which could include probation, suspension, and/or expulsion from the Boys & Girls Clubs of Marin and Petaluma Athletic activities and leagues.
